

Wills are structured to take care of loved ones, those who will most miss the times you shared. There is another important reason for a will—*a chance to be remembered.*

A will is a legal document which *communicates your decisions* after you have passed on. With a will, you decide on the disposition of your belongings and who will take care of any legal matters which may arise.
